Dr. Joel M. Levin is Chief of Plastic Surgery at Baptist Hospital of Miami. Dr. Levin earned his M.D. from the University of Miami and conducted his internship at Tulane University, at which he also served as Vice President, Intern Corps. He did his residency in General Surgery at Emory University, and Plastic Surgery at the University of Kansas Medical Center. Dr. Levin has been awarded Diplomate by the American Board of Surgery, and the American Board of Plastic Surgery.

Dr. Levin is a Fellow of American Surgeons, a member of the American Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, the Florida Medical Association, the American Association for Hand Surgery, as well as the American Society for Surgery of the Hand. Dr. Levin is a consultant in Plastic and Hand Surgery to Homestead Air Force Base and the South Dade Community Health Center in South Florida.

Dr. Levin served in the United States Air Force in General Surgery in Vietnam and Hamilton Air Force Base from 1970 until 1972. He was the Chief of Surgery at Jackson South Community Hospital in 1979 and the Chief of Plastic Surgery at Miami Children's Hospital in 1983. Dr. Levin became the Sub-Section Chief of Plastic Surgery at Baptist Hospital of Miami in 1985. He has been a member of the Dade County Medical Association, Public Service Committee since 1987 and served as the Secretary-Treasurer of the Greater Miami Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons from June 1990 to June 1991. It was in 1990 when Dr. Levin became Chairman of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at Baptist Hospital of Miami. Dr. Levin has served as President – Elect of Greater Miami Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons, the President of Greater Miami Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons as well as on the Physicians Advisory Council on Women's Services at Baptist Hospital of Miami.
